Minutes of the Committee constituted by DST to consider applications for compassionate appointment for the years 2016 & 2018.

On the recommendation of the duly constituted committee for consideration of compassionate appointment cases of DST, DSIR & DBT in accordance with the guidelines of DoP&T appointment on compassionate grounds for the year 2016 & 2018 has been done. On the basis of assessment of the documents & affidavit submitted by the applicants and points secured by the applicants and subject to the fulfillment of necessary qualification as per extant DoP&T guidelines, the committee recommended the following applicants for appointment to Group 'C' posts in DST on compassionate ground:

(i) For Year 2016: Sh. Amardeep S/o Late Sh. Satish Kumar, PMO

(ii) Year 2018: Sh.Rakesh Kumar S/o Late Sh.Ramesh Kumar, LDC

2. Since Sh. Amardeep S/o Late Sh. Satish Kumar does not have the minimum educational qualification required for appointment as MTS, therefore, as of now, he is being appointed as Trainee till he acquires the minimum educational qualification prescribed under RRs for the post of MTS i.e., 10th passed. The period spent in the service as Trainee will not be counted as service for any purpose. Maximum time allowed for a Trainee to acquire minimum educational qualification as per DoP&T's O.M. No. 14014/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 30.05.2013 is 05 years.

3. The competent authority has considered the recommendations of the Committee and accepted the same.

3. A total number of 23 applicants are eligible for consideration for compassionate appointment for the year 2016 and 26 applicants are eligible for consideration for compassionate appointment for the year 2018. The committee was informed that as per the availability of vacancies in the quota of compassionate appointment in a particular year the eligible applicants (i.e. leftover applicants from previous years plus the eligible new ones) for compassionate appointment have been considered periodically from time to time. No A-12012/01/2019-Estt.II dated, 20/08/2019.
- 5. The affidavits and documents submitted by the applicants have been assessed by the Committee. Points secured by all the applicants out of 100 points have been calculated based upon information provided in affidavit & related documents as per the 100 point criteria, issued by this Department vide O.M. No A-12012/2/2019-Estt.II dated, 20-08-2019. Loan obtained against any bank deposits are not being treated as liabilities. The points obtained by the candidates have been tabulated as under:

6. For deciding the cases of tie, where two or more candidates have secured 127696/2020/Establishment-II Committee has relied upon this Department's O.M.NO. A-12012/01/2012-Admn.I(B) dated, 21st March,2013 . According to which, the candidates who obtains highest marks under the parameter "number of dependents" (total of three sub categories) will be put at higher position. If still tie continues, the candidate who obtains highest marks under the parameter "Family Pension and Terminal Benefits" (taken together) shall be put at higher position. If still tie continues, the candidate who obtains highest marks under the parameter "Liabilities of deceased and other dependant family members" shall be put at higher position. If tie still continues, all such tied candidates would be called for interview by a Committee chaired by Joint Secretary with Welfare Officer and Deputy Secretary as members and final selection out of tied candidates would be made based on the recommendations of the Committee.

- 7. The members of the committee alongwith Shri Satbir Singh, Welfare Officer, DST on consideration of the proposal for compassionate appointment as above undertook a field visit on 05.03.2020(F/N) for field verification of the following top four candidates as per points secured . The committee visited the residence of the following 04 candidates:
