## (Department of Science and Technology) Notification

New Delhi, the ..... 2021.

G.S.R.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Department of Science and Technology (Group 'C' and 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2001 in so far as they relate to the post of Junior Technical Assistant, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method for recruitment to the posts for Junior Technical Assistant in the Ministry of Science and Technology, Department of Science and Technology, namely:-

- 1. **Short title and commencement**. (i) These rules may be called the Ministry of Science and Technology, Department of Science and Technology, Junior Technical Assistant (Group 'B' posts), Recruitment Rules, 2021.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix The number of posts, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.** The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- 4. Disqualification. No person, -
- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Saving.**— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
