- G.S.R.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Department of Science and Technology, Departmental Canteen Employees Group 'C' and 'D' posts Recruitment Rules, 1999 in so far as they relate to the post of Manager Grade II, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Manager Grade II, in the Ministry of Science and Technology, Department of Science and Technology, namely:-
- 1. Short title and commencement. (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Science and Technology, Department of Science and Technology, Departmental Canteen Manager Grade II (Group 'B' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2021.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of post, classification and level in pay matrix The number of the post, its classification, level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- 4. Disqualification. No person, -
- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in

consultation with the Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving. – Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Promotion:

Assistant Manager-cum-storekeeper in level 4 in the pay matrix (Rs. 25500 – 81100) in the pay matrix with ten years of regular service in the grade.

Note 1: The eligibility service for promotion to the post of Manager Grade II shall be eight years for persons holding the feeder posts of Assistant Manager-cum-Storekeeper on regular basis on the date of notification of these rules.

Note 2: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their

probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation:

Officers under the Central Government: -

- (a) (i) holding analogous post on a regular basis in the parent cadre or Department; or
 - (ii) with six years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the posts in level-5 in the pay matrix (Rs. 29200- 92300) or equivalent in the parent cadre or Department; or
 - (iii) with ten years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in post in level- 4 in the pay matrix (Rs. 25500 81100) or equivalent in the parent cadre or Department; and
- b) possessing the educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruitment under column (7).
- Note 1: The Departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion.
- Note 2: The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another Ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed five years.
- Note 3: The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation/absorption shall not exceed fifty-six years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
