

NOTIFICATION

No. G.S.R. ____ In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Department of Science and Technology (Staff Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1980, namely: -

1.
 - (1) These rules may be called the Department of Science and Technology (Staff Officer) Recruitment Amendment Rules, 2017
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Department of Science and Technology (Staff Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1980, in the Schedule
 - (i) for the entry in column 4, under the heading "scale of pay" the following entry shall be substituted, namely: -
Level - 11 in the Pay Matrix
 - (ii) for the entry under column 12 (now it is column 11), the following entry shall be substituted, namely: -
Officers of Central/ State Governments/ Union Territories/ Autonomous or Statutory Organization/ PSUs/ University/ Recognized Research Institution or Councils/ -
 - (a)
 - (i) holding analogous posts; or
 - (ii) having five years' service in posts in Level - 10 of pay matrix or equivalent; and
 - (b) having a bachelors' degree

Note 1: The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/ department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed four years.

Note 2: The Maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the last date of receipt of applications
